Visitors explore these questions and more at the Royal British Columbia Museum's (RBCM) Family: Bonds and Belonging exhibit. Using personal stories from First Nations, early settlers, immigrants and many others, the temporary exhibit explores our deep and often complicated relationships to each other.

As visitors engage with personal artifacts and large-scale family photos they learn about the forces that bring families together—from deep-rooted traditions, to weddings and funerals.
