The 'Imiloa Astronomy Center is the site of the world's largest collection of astronomical observatories. The center's goal was to launch the site as a tourist destination that brings together Hawaiian cultural traditions and the science of astronomy.

AldrichPears worked closely with the University of Hawai'i to develop an interpretive plan for the center that parallels Polynesian voyages across the Pacific, with astronomical voyages through space and time.
