The Mascot Gold Mine clings to a mountain cliff a kilometer above the town of Hedley. The Snaza'ist Centre sits below the mine, welcoming visitors to this historic site. The goal of the site and center is to introduce visitors to the mining history of the Similkameen Valley.

Visitors to the mine can tour its restored buildings and main mine shaft, while interacting with interpretive exhibits that describe the gold mining process.
