

150 years to celebrate 150 stories to share

In 2018, Oregon State University celebrates its 150th anniversary. This milestone provides an opportunity for celebrating past achievements, reflecting on what distinguishes this university from others, and imagining OSU's role in shaping the future. It also provides an opportunity to communicate these key aspects of the university with faculty, students, and alumni.

AldrichPears collaborated with OSU staff, the Oregon Historical Society and exhibit fabricators to develop an object-rich exhibit that communicates the impact of OSU's contributions and relevance, in Oregon and around the world.

To pique visitors' curiosity and encourage exploration, AldrichPears' design presents 150 intriguing stories about OSU. Visitors explore these stories to discover what OSU is really about—a learning, teaching and research community with a proven ability to transform. The exhibit features personal stories, memories, objects, images and AV to piece together the larger picture of how OSU has and continues to set itself apart. The design uses a modular "kit of parts" for easy assembly, disassembly, and reconfiguration in a new space or spaces.
