The Piikani (historically known as the Piegan or Blackfoot)
First Nation are at the forefront of Aboriginal governance issues
and host Canada's oldest pow wow. But there is a real need for
economic development in their community of Brocket. The Piikani
Travel Centre will capitalize on its prime highway location to serve
tourists, travellers and community members. An iconic exhibit
visible from the road acts as a landmark for the full-service stop,
which includes an interpretive area, artisan craft retail, gas station
and convenience store.

AldrichPears Associates has developed a concept and preliminary exhibit design for this small but mighty interpretive area. Facilitated workshops with Elders revealed a need for both outsiders and community members to understand the Piikani history of resilience—a story not told anywhere else. Hands-on and immersive experiences are planned that will showcase a vibrant, living culture.
