Thundering Ahead

Wanuskewin Heritage Park is a National Historic Site featuring 19 archaeological sites that reveal a remarkably complete record of pre-contact cultural development. For centuries, Indigenous groups from across the Great Plains followed the bison herds to this site year after year. Now the park is implementing a comprehensive renewal strategy for the entire site that includes reintroducing the bison.

AldrichPears worked with the park's stakeholders to develop exhibits for their first visitor centre in 1992. Decades later, APA continues to work with the Elders to create experiences that link visitors to Indigenous communities in new ways, inviting them to listen to the voices of contemporary Elders and make their own connections to this special place.

Immersive exhibits incorporating audio and digital technologies surround visitors in the beliefs, traditions and stories of Indigenous people of the Great Plains and their deep connection to the bison, past and present.
