Encounter Earth's Evolution

Darwin is a conservatory at Oltremare Marine Park where visitors travel to a tropical forest during the Cretaceous period. Representing the geological era from about 150 to 65 million years ago, visitors explore evolution through Earth's habitats, dinosaurs and other life.

APA develop a conceptual approach for Darwin, focusing on immersing visitors in the sights and sounds of primordial Earth. Visitors travel along a twisting and sloping path through diverse, ancient habitats. Volcanoes ooze and blast steam, caves crawl with insects, jungle forests echo with sounds of wild animals and a pool of crocodiles all help tell the tale of evolutionary change over time.
