With more than 40 hands-on exhibits, children explore natural environments, conduct scientific investigations and express themselves through art, captivating their inquisitive and growing minds.

APA worked with the Museum to design galleries filled with open-ended, whole-body play experiences that allow children to explore the world in new ways. APA developed a concept based on the Reggio Emilia approach to preschool and primary education, emphasizing agency, sensory experiences, collaboration and self-expression. In the immersive galleries, children can shift tectonic plates to create their own earthquakes, play the role of seismologists to examine a trench deep below the Earth's surface, see the world from a bug's viewpoint and trade items at the Nature Exchange.
