Kerry Wood Nature Centre is the interpretive hub of Red Deer's treasured Waskasoo Park. For decades, the Centre has served as the place to explore key environmental elements of the city's river valley and surrounding Aspen Parkland.

APA worked with the City of Red Deer to redesign the Nature Centre's exhibitry, engaging visitors with the local environment and conservation challenges. As a tribute to Kerry Wood—the prominent local author for whom the Centre is named—the interpretive space is designed like a book. In a series of interconnected ecological chapters, visitors interact with nature-themed exhibits anchored within large "open-book" forms that shift in appearance with the changing seasons.
