New Perspectives on the World's Tallest Trees

Save the Redwoods League has worked to protect, restore and connect people with redwood forests for over 100 years. APA is working with the League and a diverse group of stakeholders to convert a former lumber mill to a visitor center and restore the surrounding ecosystem.

Unique experiences inspire intellectual and emotional connections to the forest and its inhabitants. The secrets of the redwoods are revealed through multisensory exhibits that are respectful of the landscape and draw attention to its unique features. Visitors walk a 380-foot-long path representing the height of a redwood while revealing features not normally accessible—from underground to the canopy. Interactive exhibits challenge visitors to restore a forest and investigate their own relationships with the tallest and oldest living organisms on the planet.
