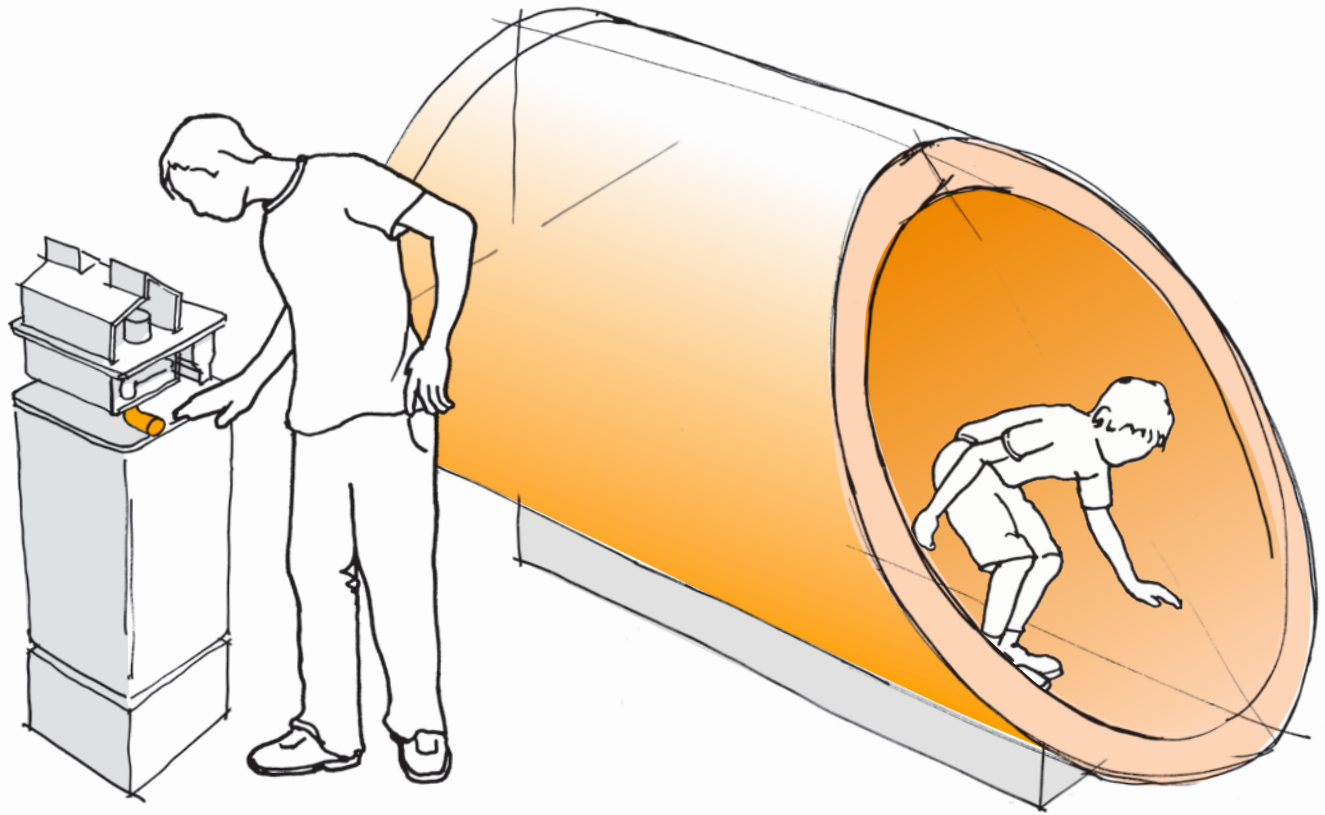


# Sapperton Pump Station

## Infrastructure Uncovered

The Sapperton Pump Station—near public greenspaces and the confluence of two rivers—protects the health of local waterways by moving raw sewage to a wastewater treatment plant.

APA worked closely with Metro Vancouver to design engaging outdoor interpretation as part of an upgraded pump station. To match the active, industrial nature of the site, visitors use durable viewscopes to explore nearby habitats. Floor maps and tactile models reveal systems normally hidden from view. Through fun, approachable visuals and stories, visitors connect their actions at home with consequences at the Pump Station and downstream.
