Perched above the Glen Canyon Dam, the Carl Hayden Visitor Center is a popular stop for visitors on their way to Lake Powell, canyon country or one of the many parks and monuments in the region.

APA worked with the National Park Service and the Bureau of Reclamation to reimagine exhibits that encourage understanding for both ecological conservationists and those who rely on the hydroelectric dam. The exhibits and stories weave together the unique geological and hydrological features of the region with how humans and wildlife interact with the Colorado River. Taking in powerful views of the 710-foot dam and Lake Powell, visitors connect to the story and reflect on their role in water conservation.
