A New Take on Washington History

The Washington State History Museum explores how history connects us. Since 1996 the Museum has served as the primary authority on state history, making it relevant to modern lives and supporting civic dialogue. They have been implementing a renewal of their original exhibits and brought in APA for a fresh perspective.

The new 360 Gallery presents Washington history in a way people haven't seen before. Visitors are invited to make connections between people, places and time to better understand the development of the state. The new approach takes visitors on a journey through the 360 mile-long state using immersive abstractions of its major biomes: prairie, mountain and coast. Visitors engage with a rich collection of objects and interactive media to try their hand at trading and exploring like early inhabitants, and to make connections to current issues.
