

The Centre will strengthen the Mi'kmaw Nation's understanding of their past while supporting future generations through meaningful visitor experiences and programming.

The in-depth design process engages Elders and curatorial stakeholders. Experiences are designed to be meaningful for Mi'kmaw people first and foremost, while also welcoming visitors from Nova Scotia, Canada, and the world.
