Puerto Rico has a deep geological history, only matched by its rich biodiversity. Yet, the island does not have a natural history museum to share these stories with visitors.

APA worked closely with Museum organizers, subject matter experts, and local enthusiasts to develop a vision for a museum that reveals the island's hundreds of millions of years of dynamic natural history. The resulting master plan offers a cohesive experience, immersing visitors in different geologic eras where they get hands-on with fossils, minerals, and rocks. Visitors manipulate models and interactive technology to discover the island's geological transformation and its vast and varied prehistoric and still-evolving plants and animals. The experience will inspire the next generation of conservationists.
