Shaped by colliding continents and grinding glaciers, Gros Morne National Park's striking landscape is on many visitors' bucket lists. Parks Canada is renovating its existing visitor center as an inclusive gathering place for visitors, Gros Morne residents, and Mi'kmaw communities.

APA is collaborating with Parks Canada staff and stakeholders to design exhibits that tell the story of continuous change over time. Large-scale topographic maps and interactive murals reveal shifting layers of life adapted to this unique geology. Listening stations introduce visitors to seasonal stories — and the human activities that have animated this place for thousands of years. Visitors will leave the center ready to make their own personal connections to the Park.
