
Exhibit Gallery at Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation Cultural Centre

Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation is building a new cultural center as an education hub and intergenerational gathering place. The exhibit gallery will reflect the Little Salmon/Carmacks people's connection to their land, the river, each other, and to their past and future.

In close collaboration with the Nation's project sponsor and current staff, APA is developing a thematic framework and concept for the exhibit gallery. This work includes in-person interviews and group workshops with citizens of the Little Salmon Carmacks First Nation to draw out the key stories and messages the community wants to communicate. Conceptual sketches illustrate initial directions for the visitor experience within the new building site on the Yukon River.
